



The German Air Force depends on a secure supply of ammunition. A distinction must be made between ammunition for aircraft weapons and guided missiles of all types. The latter includes not only air-to-air and air-to-ground guided missiles for flying units, but also effectors for ground-based air defence. Supplying these weapon systems is done from existing stockpiles, necessitating rapid follow-up procurements – such as those following the transfers to Ukraine. (Photo: German Air Force)
